B. Filling out the form

1. How to complete the various sections

Please read carefully the « **Information** » section: The information bubbles will help you complete the different information (1)

You must complete the following 6 sections of the form:

- a. Personal information: fill in your identity and personal details
 - **Name and surname**: if your name and surname contain a special character (β é è ö ä...), this may cause an error in the system, please fill in these fields without using special characters.
 - **E-mail address**: give us an email address that you regularly consult so that you do not miss important information that will be transmitted.

b. Requested stay and current studies: complete the section about your current studies and your stay at Université Paris-Saclay. Students planning to complete a thesis project must select « Studies » as the desired stay.

- **Last degree obtained**: if you are a student engineer or a student at the faculty of medicine or pharmacy, indicate *licence* (Undergraduate) if you intend to come during your 2nd or 3rd year, or *master* if you intend to come after your third year.
- **Expected date of arrival**: means when you arrive in France for the beginning of your stay.
- **Planned departure date**: means when you plan to leave France at the end of your stay.

c. Language skills: fill in your language level in French and English according to the European reference framework (<u>CEFRL</u>). Consult the document in the information bubble.

d. Further information: Let us know if you need specific arrangements for your studies.

e. Relevant documents to be uploaded – see more details below

f. Declaration of consent – Read the statements carefully and then check the boxes





2. Documents to upload

Before starting your application, make sure you have the necessary documents in **PDF** format.

- Exchange students:
 - <u>Signed and stamped transcripts of records</u> from your university (of your years in higher education). Transcripts of records must be translated into French if they are not in English or in a Latin language.
 - <u>Program of study completed and signed by you and your university.</u> The choice of courses must reach 30 ECTS per semester or 60 ECTS per year. If your university does not provide a template, you can use the template available on our website.

Warning: Please note that not all courses are open to exchange students.

If you are coming for a master thesis, please note that in France they are considered as internships. If the duration is over 2 months, interns must receive a stipend (approx. $540 \in$ /month). Make sure to discuss this with your supervisor.

- **Students receiving a scholarship** (CSC, Taiwan, etc) :
 - <u>Certificate of scolarship</u> in PDF format

3. Submitting the application

When you have completed all the sections of the form, you must send your application by clicking on the tab "**Send**" at the bottom left of the last page.

You will receive a confirmation email containing information about housing during your stay.
